



## Youngstown City School District Paul C. Bunn Elementary School Youngstown, Ohio

The Youngstown Paul C. Bunn Elementary School is a 68,000 square foot grade K-5 facility located in a more suburban 1950's era neighborhood on the outer perimeter of Youngstown. The student population has a high percentage of children with disabilities, therefore the overall design concept focused on achieving a non-institutional, home-like environment while providing accessible spaces with specialized features to meet their needs. Grade levels are grouped by "pods" along each corridor and defined by a special entrance court into each group of classrooms that is color-coded and has an animal graphic placed in the floor pattern. A multi-purpose 7,000 square foot Gymnasium & Cafeteria incorporates a large folding partition system to create flexibility for small group use as well as large school-wide functions – a space plan that became part of the OSFC Design Manual after our Taft Elementary project. Cost was \$9 million. Designed while partner with HSA.
